

MOTION FOR ARREST/DETENTION
(PROBABLE CAUSE)

The Prosecuting Attorney moves for authority to arrest and detain the above defendant based on the following affidavit.

1. Affiant is a Deputy Prosecuting Attorney for this county and makes this affidavit in that capacity.
2. The above defendant is accused of a crime(s) by an Information.
3. Affiant believes probable cause exists for the arrest and detention of the defendant because of the following facts and circumstances: Police reports indicate that in Benton County, on or about the 7th day of September, 2012, a Hanford High cheerleader, CCH, dob: 4-16-96, reported that after the Hanford-Kamiakin football game, while she was talking with other cheerleaders, a man came up behind her and grabbed her on the buttocks and vagina area under her skirt. Laurie Ann and Todd Ralenkotter, who have sons on the football team, state they saw the man push between them, get behind CCH, hit her buttocks with the back of his hand. When CCH didn't respond, the Ralenkotters state they saw the man reach under her cheerleader skirt and grab her. A Kamiakin cheerleader, TMR, states that after the game a man walked passed her and touched her buttocks, then moved his hand lower and touched her genitals under her skirt. TMR states she saw the man go out of his way to approach another Kamiakin cheerleader, SSS. The man put his hands on SSS's buttocks, according to TMR. SSS confirmed that she felt someone put hands on her buttocks as he walked past her. On 9-14-12, CHH was cheerleading for Hanford at a game with Pasco. She recognized a man in the stands as the person who touched her the previous week. She

alerted her her mother, who alerted the police. Mrs. Kalenkotter was also in the stands and positively identified the man as the person who touched CHH the previous week. The police detained the man, who was the defendant. TMR came to the location and also positively identified the defendant as the person who grabbed her and SSS the week previously. TMR and SSS further stated that they had seen the defendant previously at games and that on one occasion he followed the cheerleader squad from Burger King to the practice field. They also state that the defendant appeared to try to look up their skirts as they were warming up for the 9-7-14 game to the extent that they changed their positions. Further, on 2-2-12 a man, later identified as the defendant, was loitering around the girls locker room at a Hanford High basketball game. An assitant principal, Ken Gosney states it appeared that the defendant may have been surreptitiously taking photos of the cheerleaders bottoms. The defendant admitted to the police that he has "had a sexual problem for about the last 15 years" in particular with high school cheerleaders. He stated that he likes watching them warm up and stretch before the games and is willing to drive several hours at a time just to watch them. He admitted that he was the person who the Kamikan cheerleaders saw at Burger Ranch and at Lampson field, but claimed that he did not follow them. He stated that his travels just happened to go in the same direction. He admitted that he was the individual outside the lockerroom at the Hanford High basketball game on 2-2-12, but denied taking any photos. He also denied grabbing CCW, MTR and SSS intentionally, but did admit touching each one on the buttocks accidentally.
